


## Blackberry & Raspberry Growing Guidesheet

## **Bareroot Planting**

With all bareroot plants, spread the roots out (separate) in the hole in all directions. This ensures the plant roots get out into the surrounding soil.





## **Blackberries**

- It is highly recommended to construct a trellis see back for trellis construction instructions).
- Space plants 3 to 4 feet apart.
- Throughout Summer (once canes reach 5-6 ft) tie to trellis and tip 1' above trellis wire - this promote lateral development.
- The fruit bears heavily on the laterals the next year.
- In late Feb-early March tip each lateral to 12 15 inches in length.
- The fruiting canes can be pruned back to the crown AFTER fruit has been harvested (late summer or early spring)

## Raspberries

- Space plants 3 to 4 feet apart.
- It starts producing in August until first hard freeze.
- Once done producing the canes can be cut down to the ground, either in November or February. Large patches can be mowed over with the mower set on high.
- New sets of canes are produced in March.
- Plants may need to be thinned out in year 3.





This year's new canes (fruiting next year) are tied to the opposite wire and are tipped back during the Summer
