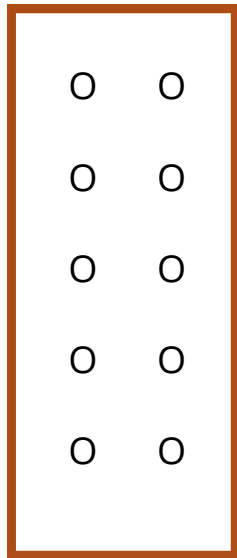

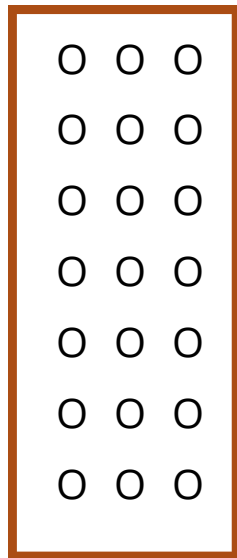

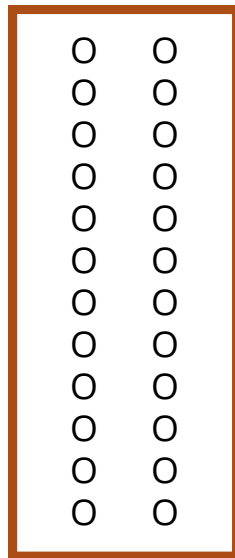
TRANSPLANTS (K-12 SCHOOLS)

Tomatoes

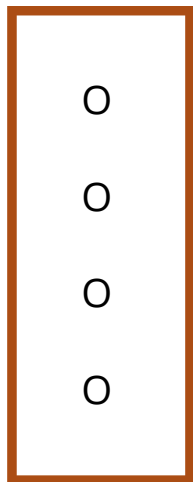


3 across 8 down
Peppers

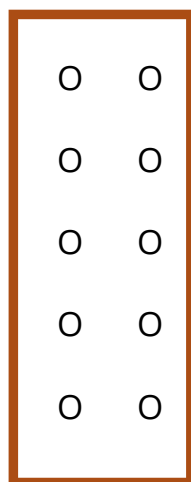


2 across 12 down
Sweet Potatoes

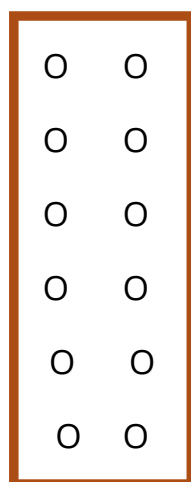
