## About KCCG

Kansas City Community Gardens empowers low income households, schools, and community groups to grow their own vegetables and fruit. We're here to provide affordable resources and share knowledge so that anyone who is willing to roll up their sleeves and dig in the dirt can be a successful gardener!

## How do I join?

You will need to purchase an annual membership to purchase seeds, plants and services from KCCG. The membership year begins on October 1 and expires the following September 30.

We offer three membership levels, based on your income and number of people in your household:

- Green Card memberships are \$2
- Yellow Card memberships are \$15
- Orange Card Memberships are \$30
- Blue Card memberships are \$45

Membership includes 10 packets of seeds, a 10 pound bag of organic fertilizer and access to all of the products and services at right at member-level pricing.

# Membership Benefits

## Seeds

KCCG's seed varieties are chosen to produce maximum harvests in the Kansas City region. Members receive 10 packs free, then may purchase additional packs.

## Vegetable Transplants

Just like our seeds, our spring, summer and fall transplant varieties are selected to be successful in the KC climate. Plants are grown in KCCG's on-site greenhouse.

## Fruit Trees & Berry Plants

We offer a selection of disease-resistant plants at affordable prices. Fruit orders are placed in early spring.

## Rental Plots

Members can rent ground plots and raised beds at nine KCCG-managed community gardens in KCMO and KCK. For a list of locations, visit [kccg.org/rent-a-plot](http://kccg.org/rent-a-plot).

## Tilling Services & Rental

KCCG offers low-cost home tilling services for Green Card members and rototiller rental for all members.

## Fertilizer

Members receive a free 10-lb. bag of organic fertilizer and can purchase additional bags and buckets at member pricing.

## Tools & Garden Supplies

KCCG carries an assortment of affordable gardening tools and supplies like tomato cages, straw, compost, pest control and row cover.

## Educational Workshops
