### **Individual & Family Gardens**

KCCG offers low-cost plants, seeds and services for home gardeners. Gardeners purchase an annual program membership, based on household income:

- Green Card memberships are \$2
- Yellow Card memberships are \$15
- Orange Card Memberships are \$30
- Blue Card memberships are \$45

Memberships include 10 packs of seeds and a 10-lb. bag of organic fertilizer. Members also gain access to low-cost vegetable transplants, additional seeds, fruit trees, garden supplies, rental plots, tilling services, free workshops and more.
